LEESBURG TOWER

Be informed, Leesburg, FL, LEESBURG(KLEE) now has a tower. Hours of operation are from 1200-0000Z (0700 - 1900 local).

LEE Class D airspace extends from the surface to 1599' MSL for a 4.1 NM Radius. Arriving aircraft should obtain the current ASOS/ATIS information and contact tower when 10 NM out for arrival instructions. Aircraft operating in the vicinity of the airport when ATCT and Class D airspace are not effective should monitor the CTAF frequency.
